This is the only residency at Central Maine Medical Center, and we serve as a clinical campus for eight (8) UNECOM medical students for their entire third clerkship year. With a strong Osteopathic curriculum, we promote a supportive environment in which to learn the breadth of Family Medicine. Residents can choose a selective from Maternity Care, CAM, Women's Health, Ambulatory Care, Emergency Medicine, Pediatrics, and Geriatrics, or they can become a part of the Wilderness and International Medicine Program (WIMP). You get to tailor your education to meet your career goals. The program is also a RHEDI-grantee so that Residents can gain competency in reproductive choices.

CMMC is a referral center for three (3) smaller rural hospitals, and there is a rural-track option in Rumford, ME, for those interested in practicing in small communities. Lewiston, ME, is located between the coast and the mountains, a short 2+ hours north of Boston.
