At the University of New England, academic programs are regularly reviewed for quality assurance. Programs without specialized accreditation undertake a review following a seven-year cycle. Programs with specialized accreditation undertake a review the semester following their full reaccreditation review. Programs with specialized accreditation that undergo a reaccreditation review every seven or more years also complete an internal review at the midpoint of their full reaccreditation review.
