Centered on core lectures, the diverse and innovative curriculum is offered on two 18-month cycles to include department and institutional Grand Rounds, Morning Conference and lectures given during our weekly morning academic sessions

In addition to didactic and clinical responsibilities, Residents are also required to complete a presentation-grade research project.

The patient populations served, range from the most economically prosperous to the most economically deprived.
